

# Enrichment Activities

## Academic Enrichment Activities



**Imagine Mars** – Students will discover what Mars is all about, what it would be like to live there, and travel there. The activity will include skyping to scientists from around the country, various investigative labs, even simple robotics. This activity will extend students' use of reading, writing, science, and math. To be enrolled a student must be performing at a passing level on all CBAs and Benchmarks as well as on report card grades. If not, the student must be enrolled in tutorials and successfully progressing toward academic goals.

**SAT Preparatory** – This is the first step toward preparing your child for college. The SAT test is a college entrance test that colleges use as one of the criteria for admission. Many colleges have a minimum score requirement for admission, and offer scholarships for very high scores. To be enrolled a student must be performing at a passing level on all CBAs and Benchmarks as well as on report card grades.

**College Exploration** – Various colleges and universities will be explored by video, presentations by recruiters, and online research. Students will compare and contrast programs from different schools. Students will also create a long term plan for getting into college and the steps to achieve their plan. To be

enrolled a student must be performing at a passing level on all CBAs and Benchmarks as well as on report card grades. If not, the student must be enrolled in tutorials and successfully progressing toward academic goals.



### Sports Enrichment Activities

The sports offered will be determined by student demand and teacher availability. Traditionally, soccer has been the sport that has the highest demand from both students and teachers. To be enrolled a student must be performing at a passing level on all CBAs and Benchmarks as well as on report card grades. If not, the student must be enrolled in tutorials and successfully progressing toward academic goals.
